The sacrament consists of three basic parts, after
the calling of the names and the homily. First, Bishop
Elizondo prays the prayer written on the left of this
bulletin page, usually over the group as a whole. The
second step is for each candidate to come forward
(with sponsor) to receive the anointing with the
Sacred Chrism Oil. During this moment Bishop
Elizondo says to each person, "Be sealed with the
Gift of the Holy Spirit." Each responds, "Amen."
Then Bishop Elizondo says to each person, "Peace
be with you." Each responds, "And with your Spir-
it" and then returns to his or her seat.
